NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No.F.5/4/65-GP., dated 11th January, 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, and in supersession of Schedule-V of the notification issued under G.O.Ms.No.109/DP&AR dated 14th December, 1992 of Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Personal Wing), Chief Secretariat, Puducherry save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'C' post of "Gardener" in the Government of Puducherry, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. - (i) These rules may be called the Government of Puducherry, Group - 'C' post of Gardener Recruitment Rules, 2020.

(ii) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. Number of post, its classification, Level in the Pay Matrix - The number of the said post, its classification and the Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications:- The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications. - No person, -

- a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

Shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:



Provided the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. – Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category or persons.

6. Savings. – Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

7.	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits	1. Should have passed SSLC or its equivalent. 2. Should have successfully completed Training at Vocational Agriculture School, Madur, Karaikal/PKKVK, Puducherry.
