Farmers from Thanikuppam, Nathamedu, Pudhukuppam and Karikalampakkam brought affected samples for which recommendations were given by the Agricultural Officer Mrs. Aruna (Agricultural Officer) and Mrs. Girija of MSSRF. Around 30 farmers participated in the plant clinic.
